





You can qualify for entry to an undergraduate degree at one of 70+ NCUK partner universities. A foundation programme can help you meet the academic and English requirements to enter the first year of your chosen degree.



London is one of the most diverse and cosmopolitan cities in the world. Over 300 languages are spoken, and there are almost limitless social and cultural experiences to enjoy – from music to museums and theatres to sports events.



Accommodation

Where you live is important and we're here to help our students find accommodation that best meets their needs.

We have good options for students to suit a range of budgets either on site or within an easy commute to our centre.



Residence

Residence accommodation is recommended for students who appreciate being independent, prefer to cook for themselves, and live in a social setting with fellow international students. All accommodation has been assessed by our Student Accommodation team for its suitability and location.

IQ Sterling Court is a convenient choice for students studying at NCUK International Study Centre, based at Malvern House London. It's roughly a ten-minute walk to Wembley Park station which services the Jubilee & Metropolitan Underground lines.

World famous Wembley Stadium, home of football is right on your doorstep, with the beautiful pedestrianised Olympic Way, full of shops, cafes and restaurants a couple of minutes' walk away. For music fans, Wembley Arena concert space is also close by, hosting world-famous artists.

House share

Twin, double and single rooms, decorated in contemporary style. Each house has a living area with TV and a garden or outside area. There is weekly cleaning of common areas and bathrooms (including en-suites bathrooms).

Homestay

Homestay accommodation is available to all students, and is required for those under 18 years of age. It's a chance to experience local life, a home away from home, and to learn things from your host that you would probably never learn in the classroom. Our hosts are a reflection of the cities they live in: where they live, who they live with, the type of building they live in, the jobs they do, and how they spend their free time. But all of them are curious about international students and other cultures, and enthusiastic about sharing their lives and interests with others. All hosts for under-18s have completed the required local council background and police (DBS) checks.



Homestay features:

- ─ Single room
- ─ Shared bathroom
- ─ Bed linen, towels
- ─ Wifi
- ─ Access to a washing machine

Options:

- ─ Meal plan: self catering, breakfast (B&B), breakfast and dinner (half board)
- ─ Private bathroom
- ─ Twin (shared) room
- ─ Special diets
- ─ Homestay hosts are 25-60 minutes travel from the centre

Next steps

1. Application:

Submit your application online: www.ncuk.malverninternational.com/apply-now or scan the QR code below



Our team will contact you to submit your supporting documents:

- A copy of your passport
- A copy of your academic transcript and certificate
- Proof of your English language level (UKVI IELTS or equivalent)
- A Personal Statement

Additional documentation may be required depending on your application. If our team need more information, we will let you know.

2. Admissions assessment:

Our Admissions team will review your application and documents. Some students may be called for pre-screening so keep an eye out for a call from us.

3. Offer letter:

We will send you an offer letter. It may be conditional and we'll let you know what we will need from you, or it will be unconditional.

If we think the course is not right for you, we will suggest an alternative.

4. Accept your offer:

To hold your place on the course, you will need to meet all the remaining conditions. We can only confirm your place once all conditions have been met and the deposit paid. Please note that if you require a visa to study with us, you may need to provide additional evidence to comply with the visa regulations in the UK. You may also need to pass a credibility interview. We'll let you know more about how to prepare.

5. CAS issued:

Once you have paid your remaining fees, met all the conditions of offer and passed a credibility interview if required, we will confirm your place and send you a Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS). You will need this to obtain a visa. Please note a CAS can only be issued up to six months before the start of the course (if you apply from outside the UK) or up to three months (if you are eligible to apply from within the UK).

6. Apply for visa:

You will then need to apply for your visa. It is your responsibility to obtain a visa before you travel to join the course. If you do not have a valid visa for studies in the UK, you will not be able to join the course.

7. Arrival:

You should arrive on the weekend before the start date of the course. Please tell us when you are coming. We will send you pre-arrival information about your course and life in the UK.
